Patient Exclusion Criteria



The patient should meet the following criteria which must be considered by the clinical team and/or MDT (and recorded):

The criteria may be relaxed **IF** local risk assessment discussed by the team and/or MCRG deems surgery to be of greater benefit than the risk – and the patient agrees and consents to surgery.

Covid-19 General Admission Criteria

The risk assessment should consider:

- The level of COVID-19 locally.
- The ability of the unit to offer a green pathway for surgery, and should the green pathway be broken the ability to mitigate risk in that situation.

If the risk is considered to be significant the following risk factors should be taken into account:

- Age
- Ethnicity Black, Asian Minority Ethnic
- Co-morbidities e.g. BMI, diabetes,
 - \circ BMI < 40kg/m²
 - o Current smokers or vaping
 - o ASA score I or II
 - ASA III patients <u>must be stable</u> and will need Anaesthetic / MDT risk assessment before decision to list.
- Social circumstances
 - No complex social issues that may delay discharge eg. if the patient lives alone or is a carer and would need help to 'shield'
- Not planned for HDU / ITU post-operatively (level 2 or 3 care)
- No diarrhoea/ vomiting within last 48 hours
- Not requiring Obstetric Care
- No current unstable mental health condition or receiving mental health treatment
- No patients under the age of 16 years requiring overnight stay on the ward
- No patient currently undergoing chemotherapy of radiotherapy
- No recent hospital admissions over the past 2 weeks leading up to the date of operation
- Not a resident in nursing home/residential home or care home
- Not a healthcare worker with any healthcare contact in the previous 4 weeks. Must have shielded for 14 days with a negative COVID 19 swab72 hours prior to admission.

Patient Exclusion Criteria



Clinical Exclusion Criteria

The following patients are <u>unsuitable</u> for surgery at Pinehill Hospital:

- <u>Unstable</u> ASA III and above for general anaesthetic / sedation
- Poorly controlled hypertension (BP must be less than 180/110 mmHg in clinic or > 160/100 by GP in last 12 months)
- Chronic stage 3 or 4 kidney disease
- MI or unstable angina in the last 6 months
- Coronary artery stenting in last 12 months
- TIA (transient ischaemic attack) within the last 6 months
- CVA within last 9 months
- BMI \geq 40 kg/m². (All patients with a BMI of over 35 kg/m² will need Anaesthetic / MDT risk assessment before decision to list)
- Unstable Diabetes with HbA1c >69 mmol/mol (All diabetic patients must be discussed prior to listing)
- Some Cardiac Device Patients (will need Anaesthetic / MDT risk assessment before decision to list).
- Some patients using CPAP or NIPPV (will need Anaesthetic / MDT risk assessment before decision to list).

If you have any doubt regarding the suitability of your patient to have surgery, please discuss with POA.
